## In the Flesh

John 1:14 Jesus became flesh and "pitched His tent" with us.

Philippians 2:6-8 becomes human, a servant, obedient to a terrible death

Hebrews 4:14-5:8

15-sympathizes with weaknesses tempted in every way

5:2-gentle w/misquided & ignorant

7-loud crying & tears

8-learned obedience through suffering

Jesus doesn't merely "feel bad" for our struggles & hurts...

He chooses to experience & suffer them Himself. lonely, sad, scared, betrayed, tortured to death

He does this to connect with us, to love us, to save us v.9

4:16 let us draw near with confidence

We tend to draw away because of weakness, temptations, failures
Ephesians 2:12-13 brought near by the blood of Christ

You don't get closer to God by being good or getting better.

You are brought near because He loved you, pitched His tent with you, suffered & struggled for you, and then DIED for you
