The Decision Tree

Genesis 3:1-6
Contexts
Knowing Good & "Evil"
Deuteronomy 1:39
Isaiah 7:15-16
1 Kings 3:9

-refers to children needing to learn wisdom.

-Adam & Eve needed wisdom to rule

not "evil" but "bad" tov & ra Isaiah 31:2; 45:7

God "sees" what is good (Genesis 1) and what is not good (Genesis 2:18)

Genesis 3, Eve "sees" the fruit is good
a delight to the EYES
God said tree "not good"
Eve decides tree "is good"
Adam & Eve choose to determine good & bad for themselves, rather than rely on God
Proverbs 14:12; 16:25

Deuteronomy 12:8 Judges 21:25

Application

The problem isn't breaking a rule, it was choosing to decide the "rules" for themselves.

They would choose "good & bad" on their own, based on desires.

This decision caused immediate division

- -they hid from one another
- -they hid from God

Our culture: we decide what is "good" for ourselves.

How often do you depend on your "own eyes" based on your desires?
